“The Trouble with TABOR” Forums to be Held Statewide

Madison – In response to Legislative leadership’s promise of another move to amend Wisconsin’s constitution to set restrictions on local and state spending and taxation, the Wisconsin Council on Children and Families will hold community forums statewide to help communities understand the effects of TABOR in Wisconsin. “The Trouble with TABOR” forums will present information on the effects of the proposed constitutional change on families and communities, present information on the Colorado experience with TABOR and share the local perspective in each of the six communities currently scheduled for forums.
