Note: Significance of Indicated Poverty Levels:

115% is the maximum income level for participation in W-2.

130% is the maximum income level for Food Shares (food stamp) eligibility.

150% is the income level at which premiums are required for BadgerCare participation.

185% is the maximum income level for eligibility for child care, Healthy Start, BadgerCare** and WIC (Women, Infants and Children supplemental nutrition program).

**200% is the maximum income level for eligibility for child care and BadgerCare for families that qualify initially at or below 185%.
